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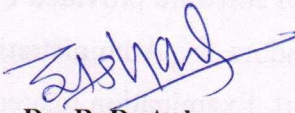

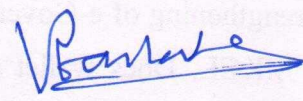
Compliance Report 2020-21

1. Four IQAC meeting were conducted during the academic year wherein, discussion, planning and scheduling of various quality assurance initiatives was accomplished. Minutes of all the above mentioned meetings were recorded and ATR duly prepared.
2. Commencement of 10 new value added courses and certificate course in Yoga.
3. Skill enhancement and capability development activities for students were organized namely, 01 soft skill activity, 03 Language and Communication Skills, 05 Life skill and 04 awareness of trends in technology programmes.
4. 6 Days Online Workshop on 'Research Methodology' was organized between 5th and 10th April 2021.
5. 36 Research projects were initiated, 24 by teachers and 12 by research scholars with their respective guides as the co-investigators and successfully completed through utilization of RUSA grant. 48 projects were entered in Avishkar Research Convention of which 14 projects were selected at the University round. One gold and one bronze medal were secured therein. Acquisition of plagiarism software 'Ouriginal' for maintenance of publication ethics. Advancement in research facilities.
6. Acquisition of MS Teams license to be used as the platform for online teaching-learning process.
7. Strengthening of e-Governance through use of software provided by Tally.ERP 9, MKCL, Docs wallet and Schoolguru vendors for Administration, Finance and Accounts, Student Admission and Support, Examination related work.
8. Process of upgrading and updating College website was continued.



9. A feedback module comprising of a predesigned questionnaire prepared by the feedback committee was developed and linked to the website in order to facilitate recording of the feedback. Feedback was then obtained from stakeholders on four aspects namely overall institutional performance, curriculum, teachers and the teaching learning process. 3219 students recorded their feedback on institutional performance. An algorithm was used to analyze the feedback; constructive suggestions received therein were placed in the minutes of BOS, Academic Council and Governing Body meetings for taking necessary action.
10. Augmentation of academic facility and surveillance equipment through acquisition of new computers and increased internet bandwidth for technical upgradation, increased CCTV surveillance, Video Conferencing system and other necessary furniture.
11. The process of developing Makerspace and Yoga Center was continued during the academic year.
12. Following Workshops, Seminars, Training programmes on quality/subject related themes were organized:
 - a. One Day Faculty Development Program on “Heal-thy Teaching” on 18/02/2021 for teaching staff.
 - b. Training on use of MKCL Software on 27/07/2020 for non-teaching staff.
 - c. Training programs on use of MS Teams platform for online teaching
13. Two Divyangajan friendly washrooms have been developed. Acquisition of ‘KIBO’ software in library for Divyangjan friendly translation and audio facility.


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
