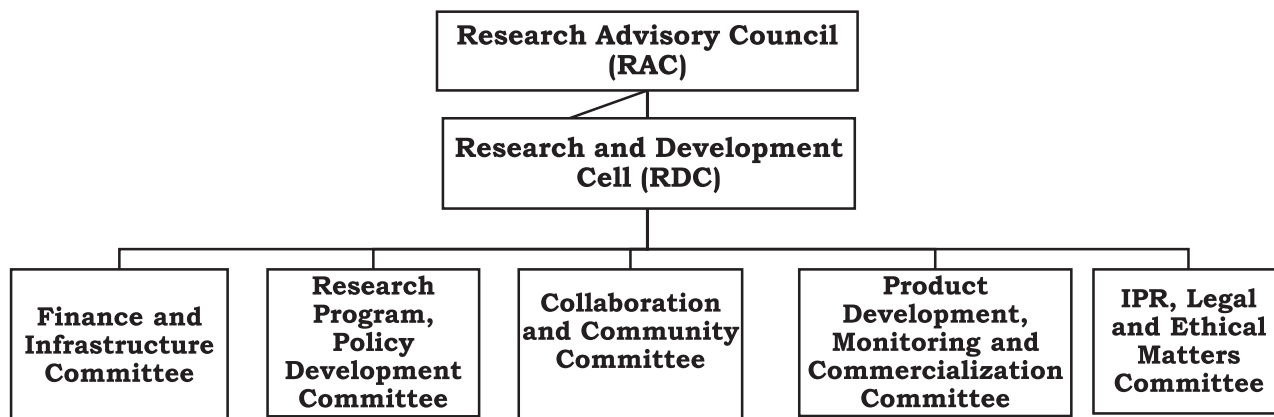




Composition and Functions of Research and Development Cell
