Policy Document for Slow, Medium and Advanced Learners

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Categorization of Learners:

- Slow Learners (SL): Students who score less than 50% marks in the previous year examination.

- Advanced Learners (AL): Students who score more than 70% marks in the previous year examination.

Support for Slow Learners:

- Bridge Courses: Offer bridge courses to bridge the knowledge gap.

- Question Bank: Create a question bank with practice questions to improve understanding.

Encouragement for Advanced Learners:

- **Promotion:** Recognize and promote advanced learners by providing opportunities for leadership roles.
- Research Activities: Encourage participation in research projects, seminars, and workshops.
- **Research-Related Competitions:** Prepare them for research-related competitions at the inter-collegiate level.
- Inter-Collegiate Competitions: Support their participation in academic and extracurricular competitions.

Mentorship Program:

• Allocation of Mentor Teachers: Assign dedicated mentor teachers to each learner.

- Academic Guidance: Mentor teachers will provide academic support and guidance.
- **Personal Support:** Mentor teachers will also address personal challenges affecting academic performance.
- **Regular Meetings:** Schedule regular one-on-one meetings to discuss progress and concerns.
